 - Paid \$40,000 dollars to assist the County with Master Plan Amendment August of 2015
- Lease control of subject property obtained October of 2017
- Rink 1 Open: ASAP

- 42,372 sf ground floor, 5,672 sf mezzanine
- Skate rental with a pro-shop and skate sharpening
- Raised bleachers for easy observation
- Climate-controlled lobby, three birthday party/meeting rooms and vending area
- 2nd story mezzanine for socializing and easy bleacher access
